

**Instrument of Government for
Bishop Wilson and Christ Church, Church of England Primary Schools
Federation**

1	The names of the federated schools are Burton Bishop Wilson and Christ Church, Church of England, Primary schools
2	The schools are both voluntary aided schools.
3	The name of the Governing Body is 'The Governing Body of Bishop Wilson and Christ Church, Church of England Primary Schools Federation'.
4	The Governing Body shall consist of: The Executive Head Teacher 2 elected Parent governors 1 elected Staff governor 1 Local Authority governor 1 Co-opted governor 8 Foundation governors
5	The total number of governors is 14
6	Foundation governors, other than the ex-officio Foundation governors shall be appointed as follows: 3 governors by the Chester Diocesan Board of Education 3 governors appointed by the Chester Diocesan Board of Education in consultation with the Parochial Church Council of Burton St Nicholas and the Parochial Church Council of Ellesmere Port
7	A) The holders of the following offices shall be Foundation governor ex-officio: The principal officiating minister in the parishes of Ellesmere Port and of St Nicholas church, Burton B) The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the schools are situated shall be entitled to appoint a Foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio Foundation Governor whose governorship derives from the office named in a) above, in the event that the ex-officio Governor is unable or unwilling to act as a Foundation Governor or has been removed from office.
8	The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the schools are situated shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio Foundation Governor and to appoint a substitute Governor.
9	Each school has a separate trust which operates for the benefit of that school.
